### The President's Comments

#### <u>Zebras</u>

My second round of babies by my pair of CFW's started with the Hen starting to lay, as stated in last month's article, before the baby had left the box. This time she made two separate nests in the one box (flat nests). She laid eggs in both ends of the nest – 3 in one end and 3 in the other. When the first hatched to be honest I thought it was dead, but no, the next day there were two babies but still I egg. In the meantime, the eggs from the other end started to hatch. So now I had four babies and two eggs but on a subsequent day there were three babies one end and one the other end. It seems she or he moved one of the chicks.

The parents carried on in the same way of feeding as with the first chick but with one exception – the chick from the first nest keeps going in and out of the nest box. I assume it is helping with the new chicks.

They have now left the nest box and the colour is nothing like CFW's.

My second pair raised six chicks. Five are an orange colour and one I think looks like a young Bullfinch. They are all doing well. The Hen has gone back to nest, so I will wait and see what happens next.

Since all the babies have left the nest I have seen the youngster from the first nest going round feeding all the CFW's chicks from the second round.

#### **Gouldians**

Meanwhile I have two nest boxes with Gouldians in and from the amount of noise coming from them it brings me to the idea that there are several young in both boxes. As I have said before, because of the way the nests are built you cannot see what is in them. Unfortunatley, a few days after writing this piece for the Newsletter I found the CFW Cock dead on the feeder. I think he just wore himself out

At this time of the year we are fast coming to the end of the breeding season, especially for Canaries. British and Foreign will go on for a little longer. I hope you have got your brooms ready, or, if you have a few bob, your hoovers, because as you know, we are fast approaching the moult when our sheds will be full of feathers. This, to me, is the worst time of year, when your birds look like they have been pulled through a hedge backwards. So, all you can do is keep your birds well fed with plenty of baths and look forward to seeing your birds when the moult is over.

All being well you should have some nice quality birds not only for showing, but to grace your cages. Also for selecting your birds for the coming season.

After the last few years we have had I hope you all have had, if not a marvelous year, a very good year, with some beautiful birds to make you feel better.

Feel free to write and tell us how your season has gone. Your ups and downs. I personally hope you have only had a few downs, and have had a great season. So come on put pen to paper and let us know.
