#### **The President's Comments**

As you will all know our last Meeting was our AGM and I was pleasantly surprised to see over 40 Members present.

Richard opened the Meeting by asking the 2023 Committee if they were willing to stand again. All said yes. So, with the ok from Members present, Richard declared the Committee be sworn in as the Committee for 2024.

Someone brought up about Team Dagenham going round other Clubs and Shows. They said it was mainly British reports and said there should be more support for the other Sections. I said they can have all the support they need. All they have to do is send in reports to Barry or Val to put in the Newsletters. I hope someone takes note and writes in.

There were two presentations – flowers for Val and Fran for all the work they do. Then an award to me for service to the Club for over 70 years. May I say thank you and can I also say it has been a joy and a pleasure to serve this great Club and I hope I can carry on for a few more years yet.

One more thing I would like to say is a big thank you to Les Rix for stepping in to do the raffle and to Dick for folding said tickets. Also Steve Wallis for taking some photos on Barry's behalf.

I would also like to say thanks to Val for running the kitchen as well as all the other jobs she has to sort out on the day.

It was a hard morning's work, but well done all. Thank you.

As I have said before, this is the time of year when subs are due. At our last Meeting we had about 20 Members pay their subs. I brought up about some Members paying on their Show Entry Forms. I think some people looked at the form and paid the wrong amount and I am surprised as they have been Members for some time, so I look forward to hearing from all Members who still have to pay. I put this in the Newsletter not to insult people but as a gentle reminder.

At the present moment there seems to be a bit of controversy over Members stewarding their own Section. I personally think this is not a problem because if you go to an all Norwich, Border, Budgie, All-British or All-Fife Show do they bring in specialist Stewards or do they go with the people who breed these birds and are Members of said Societies? I think this is a no brainer. So come on lads, put this to bed and let's get on with the running of our Shows.

I think if you want people to bring their birds to Shows you need good Judges and Stewards who know how to do the job, so, therefore, you need Stewards who know the birds and how to treat them and their cages.

These are only my views.

Finally, you will all be glad to know that Fran is out of hospital and is fine and looking forward to doing your Bacon & Hot Dog Rolls at the next Meeting.

#### The Secretary's Comments

Thank you to all members who attended the Club's AGM. The Committee stood down and was re-elected for 2024. Pete then talked through the Clubs accounts (see below) which were then passed by the members present.

We then went through the plan of this year's meeting days, which are shown above, with still a few to arrange. We have had to move the date of our annual show this year as it clashed with the all-British show, so it was put to the floor to vote for either the 7<sup>th</sup> December or 30<sup>th</sup> November. The 7<sup>th</sup> December got the vote but unfortunately the hall had a provisional booking on that date which has now been confirmed, so the annual show will be on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> November. We know there is a specialist Fife show the following day, so the numbers in our Fife section will be down which is a shame as it's one of our larger sections. This clash will only happen every 7 years.

We went on to any other business and members raised some good ideas. However, a member made comments about (a) stewards talking to judges while the judging was being done (to influence the outcome) and (b) stewards, stewarding in the sections they were showing in. A couple of years ago we had the rule in place that this could not happen. However last year we changed that rule for this to happen. As this is clearly the best practice.

Steve Wallis (Show Manager) and myself who were in charge of the management of the stewards were happy that no steward crossed the line in terms of conversation with any judge and in fact all stewards worked very hard on the day and acted in a professional manner at all times.

Please note that this member's comments were his own and were not the views of the committee or any other member at the meeting.

On a good note, we finished the meeting by presenting our President & Treasurer Peter Decort with a stunning Glass Plaque for his 70+ years' service to Dagenham CBS. Well done Pete very well deserved.
