## The President's Comments

I lived all, or should I say, most of my life in Rush Green. Romford had a cattle and sheep market on Saturdays. The whole of the Market Place was full of pens with most types of animals for sale. But the best part of it was that most of Rush Green was full of farmland and meadows. The street I lived in was on the edge of farmland on one side and Rush Green Hospital on the other. The street was a new development, so all the families were of roughly the same age, with lots of children my age. Great times, although things and times were very hard and money short.

So, we, i.e. the kids, were very lucky in that we had so many places to roam and spend our time. The best place for me was The Chase and, over the years, my friends and I knew every nook and cranny. The Chase had a big area of ponds, fields, river i.e. The Rom. There were lines of hedges, small forests and marsh land to be explored. The area covered miles. From the back of May & Bakers at Dagenham East across to Elm Park, down to Roneo Corner and along the back of Rush Green and to the rear of Rush Green Hospital.

This was a great place to find birds, and find them we did. There were all types of Finches, Blackbirds and Thrushes. We even had Ring Ouzels. All types of Tits, Skylarks, Wagtails, you name them, they were there. There was a bomb crater that was full of newts and fish. There was a large black pipe nearly covered in grass and if you pulled the grass back there were different types of snakes. In another area was a large fishing lake, with a smaller lake you reached by a small bridge. This had all types of Waders on. We had many years of fun in and around the fields and lakes.

One of my favourite places was a large field behind Garrots Riding School. They rented most, if not all of The Chase. This area was covered with small bushes and gorse and was alive with Linnets sitting in the top branches singing their hearts out. Every bush in the summer seemed to have a nest with Linnets in. In some areas where the blackberries and stinging nettles grew through the bushes, you would find White Throat nests.

After many years, a lot of the area was taken over for sand pits. The sides of these pits were taken over by Sand Martins to dig out and build their nests.

There's much more I could write about The Chase, but I'll call it a day for now.

<u>Our Club</u> – To all Club Members, may I, on behalf of the Committee, say many thanks for your support on a wonderful and happy year and, I hope you will all agree, keeping Dagenham at the forefront of CBS's. May this continue for long into the future. Well done all.

## January's Meeting – AGM

This month is our AGM. 
