The President's Comments

June's Meeting was a talk by Malcolm Thornton and he spoke about his cages and flights and the type of foreign birds he keeps.

He also spoke about how he and Len March set up the Bird Keeping Association. I believe this was back in 2015. From day 1 it has got stronger and stronger. He answered many questions and at the end the Members showed their appreciation in the usual manner.

When I was a lot younger I started in Foreign with not only Bourks, but also a few Zebras and Bengalese in a flight.

As I have said before, I have some lovely Gouldians still in a long flight (ornamental) but it was full of Gouldians so I decided to buy a few Zebras as I now have more time to sit and watch the birds.

I have bred quite a few Gouldians but I do not know a great deal about breeding said birds. I find them very secretive. I don't see them coming or going to their nest. The first thing I am aware of are the noises coming from the box.

The Zebras are, I find, totally different. Both pairs dive in and out of their nest boxes all the time. But the thing I have noticed is they take it in turn to go in and out of the nest box when they are sitting and will not let any other birds settle near it.

As I have said, now having time to watch these birds when they have young, either the Cock or the Hen sits outside the nest box, but as soon

as either leaves the box, the other one takes over at the box entrance and, as soon as they have both fed the chicks they fly off to have a feed together. Then the process starts all over again.

Question? Has anyone else noticed this in their Zebras or any other of their Finches?

I personally thought it may be because of the shortage of room in the nest box, with how many chicks there are, but one of my pairs only had one chick while the other pair has, I think, four, but the procedure is the same with both pairs.

Also the pair with only one chick started to lay a second clutch before the chick had left the nest. I have also noticed the Cock of the second pair taking bits of dry grass and other material in the box while the chicks were only about ten days old.

Another thing I have noticed, and I think this may be the reason, I have given them quite large nest boxes. Therefore most of the pairs have built fully domed nests inside the box, so it is only when the young start to move around and squash the nest down that you can see how many babies there are.
