

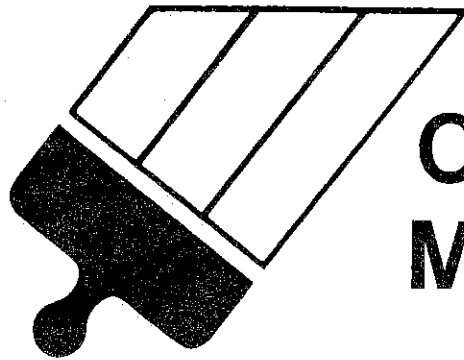

The Dagenham and District Cage Bird Society was founded 39 years ago by a few people who moved from the London area to the then "new town" of Dagenham. They had been members of societies in their previous districts and decided to form a club in Dagenham.
