Species listed on schedule 3 part 1 of the Wildlife and Countryside act 1981 and the DOE Licence WLF 100094/5 & WLF 100007 will be accepted on the condition that the owner will be responsible for providing proof of ownership to any Official law enforcement agency if requested. Any schedule 4 Softbill up to and including the size of a Wheatear may be exhibited in singles or pairs, any large Softbill must be exhibited as a single bird only.




