#### **The President's Comments**

As you all know, we had our AGM in January.

There were other things discussed at the Meeting and it closed with a minute's silence for Vic Rampling.

Again, as Treasurer, may I say thank s to all who paid their subs at the Meeting. We have quite a few people still to pay, so I hope to see cheques drop through my letterbox or I will see you at the next Meeting.

Subs have not changed although prices of everything to do with the Newsletter have. As I have said before, subs just about cover the cost. If you are not sure if you have or haven't paid see me at the next Meeting and we will sort it out.

I have just paid Richard the bill for the Hall. This was £510.00. This is good as the price has not gone up since we have been at Wantz Hall.

One of our biggest bills each month is stamps which cost in the region of £40 - £50 and sometimes more. That's enough about bills.

So I think we should try and put up more Canaries, Foreign and Budgies. Let's see if we can get more Canary and Foreign Members at the Club.

As I was saying before, no Yorkshires or Borders either. There's a challenge. Let's see if we can get more of these people interested to come to our Club.



#### February 2023 Meeting

#### This is the First Round of the Dagenham CBS Show League 2023

We have changed the format of the show to try to give a more balanced outcome.

Members can only enter the maximum of 4 Birds for each show (50p per cage)

#### <u>Judges</u>

Jim Galbally – British John Martin – Canaries Peter De Cort – Foreign

Judges will judge each section 1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup>. Any birds outside these positions will be awarded 5 points.

Points for each position are as follows  $-1^{st} = 150$ ,  $2^{nd} = 140$ ,  $3^{rd} = 130$ ,  $4^{th} = 120$ ,  $5^{th} = 110$ ,  $6^{th} = 100$ ,  $7^{th} = 90$ ,  $8^{th} = 80$ ,  $9^{th} = 70$ ,  $10^{th} = 60$ ,  $11^{th} = 50$ ,  $12^{th} = 40$ ,  $13^{th} = 30$ ,  $14^{th} = 20$ ,  $15^{th} = 10$  points.

If there are less than 15 birds in a section the points will be diluted down as per the below examples:-

- Only 5 birds in a section,  $1^{st} = 50$ , 2nd = 40,  $3^{rd} = 30$ ,  $4^{th} = 20$ ,  $5^{th} = 10$  points.
- Only 3 birds in a section, 1<sup>st</sup> = 30, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 20, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 10 points

Best bird in show from the 3 sections will receive 25 bonus points.

All members' scores will be calculated together to create the Show League Table.

#### Prizes for each show

Best Bird in Show – £30.00 + Large Rosette Best British – £10.00 + Rosette Best Canary – £10.00 + Rosette Best Foreign – £10.00 + Rosette

#### **Prizes after both shows**

1<sup>st</sup> Place – Shield + Trophy + £50.00 2<sup>nd</sup> Place – Trophy + £30.00 3<sup>rd</sup> Place – Trophy + £20.00
