Again, AOV Canaries – 2; Lizards – 4; Old Variety – 6.

I see that the Coloured Canaries, Irish Fancy and Razza Canaries are making a comeback, or should I say they are getting a better following?

Also, the Foreign Section only had eight birds shown - disappointing.

On paper I must say "Well Done" to the British Section, also to the Fife Section.

Could it be possible that some people i.e. Members, didn't show because they did not want to register their birds, so they did not have a Registration Number for their Entry Form? Perhaps they thought this was hard to get, but I heard that some people got their numbers in a matter of days.

Apart from all that I would like to say "Well Done" to the people who gave their time and effort to put on the Show. Well done all.

Before I say a sad farewell again, I would like to wish all of you a Prosperous and Happy New Year and a wonderful breeding season. Goold Luck all.

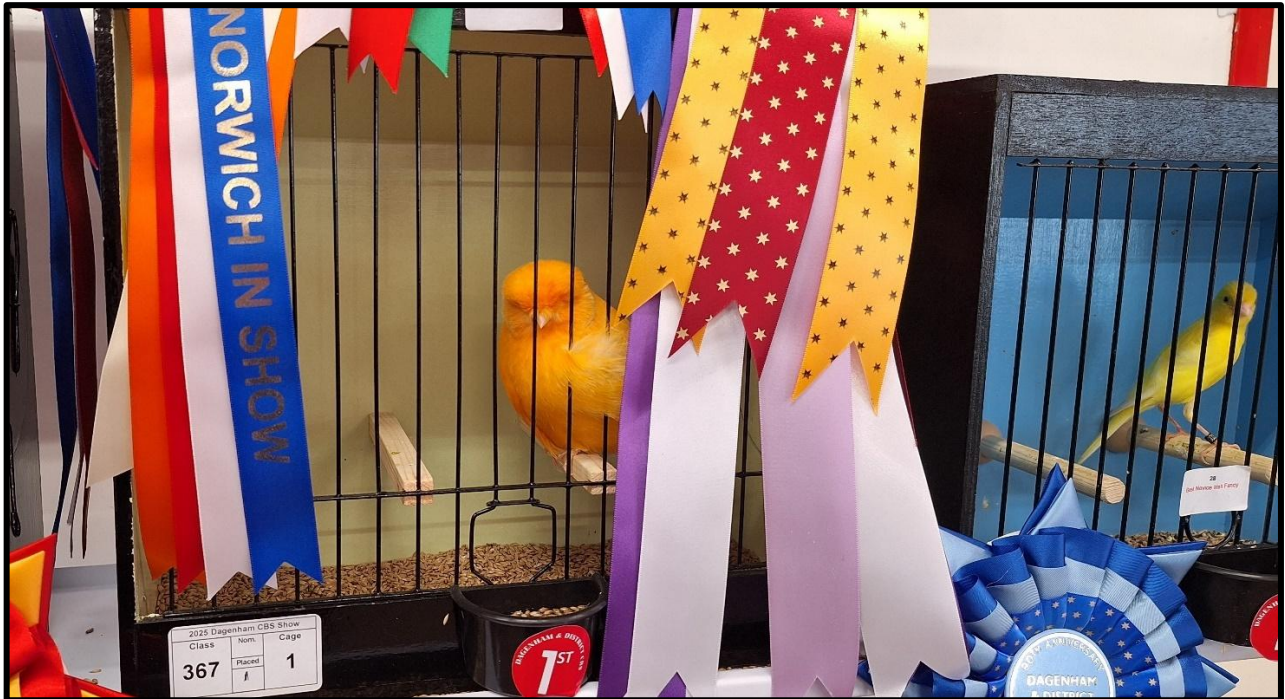
