# A Day At The Zoo by Peter Decort

When we walked in we went into the Tropical House. They had free flying birds and butterflies. These would land on you if you stood still. They had a flight full of Javas and Gouldians. These were popping in and out of their nest boxes. They also had other birds running in and out of the shrubbery.

When we went outside we were greeted with the most beautiful Sulphur Crested Cockatoo. At first he was a bit aloof staying at the back of his flight. People were not taking much notice of him, but when I approached his flight he came bounding down to the front as if we were old friends. He said "Hello" to me and started to display. His crest came up and he was bouncing. Then the people were looking and taking photos

He would not leave me alone. Wherever I went he followed putting his foot through the wire so he could get hold of my finger and getting annoyed when I wouldn't let him touch me. He was a magnificent bird. Needless to say I went back to his flight many times.

They also had a beautiful pair of Hyacinth Macaws, some Blue & Gold Macaws, Owls and Birds of Prey.

There was a paddock full of Goats. You could walk round with them. Although they said "Do not touch", who could resist??

There were also Wallabies along the pathway. When I leaned down to get a proper look, out from the pouch popped a Little Joe. I have never been so close to these before, so it was a first, and beautiful to see.

They had the Meercats in their enclosure, with a difference. You could actually go in and sit with them and they would come and sit on you and let you stroke them.

There were many other different animals to see but, for me, it was back to the Cockatoo. It brought back memories of when I had them and hand reared them.

It was a lovely day.


