The breeding season has now started and some of you should be seeing some results. If you would like to share them with a few photos please send them to Barry and he will do his best to put them in next month's newsletter.

Our Facebook page is going to be changed so that you can join the Group and add pictures and stories to the page yourself. I am new to Facebook so I needed some help to make the changes. But what I have learnt is that it is a great form of communication. Talking about communication, last month I asked if you would share your phone number for the club's website so that all members can keep in touch. Sad to say not one member called me to agree which is a shame. I'm not quite sure of the reason for the lack of interest to do this. Personally I have a large Friends & Family circle and work colleagues to talk with on a daily basis, but some of our members live alone or are on lockdown with very little social interaction. We are all witnessing difficult times, so please go out of your way to call two people a day, just for 5 minutes to

ask how they are, what they are up to, how the birds are going. You can make a difference.

My breeding season so far

I put my nest sites in around the middle of April. Some feeders took to making nests straight away with a nest of Fifes and 2 nests of Red Factors now being fed well by the parents.

I had clutches of Greenfinch Mule and Siberian Bullfinch also, but both were clear, however both have now made another nest so let's see what happens this time round.

My Linnet Mule pair, Canary x Bullfinch pair and another pair of Bullfinches both laid their 3rd & 4th eggs this morning. Other Mule & Hybrid pairs are moving nesting material around but no good nests. My Greenfinches and Siskins are doing nothing at the moment.

In regards to the new staging we have another couple of avenues to follow up so will have more news next month but please see article below.

Update on New Staging

Fergus McCarthy put me in touch with a friend called Dave Rands who has purchased new show staging for his bird club. It is white metal, each bay is 6ft wide and 4 shelves high both sides, so you get 48 show cages on each bay. The unit concertinas out and the shelves clip on (no nuts & bolts) then each unit butts up to the next unit as they are all free standing. Dave said that one person can put up one unit in less than 5 minutes. Each unit is 120 euros (£110) plus a collection charge ?????. To use the same footprint as our staging we would need 15 units which holds 450 show cages, but because of the 4th level it would give us a capacity of 720 cages in the same footprint, we would also need 5 units for judging stands, so I think 20 units could do it for around 2,400 euros (£2,200) plus collection charge. It's a big difference from our first estimate of £6,500.00. The Committee will have a conference call to discuss.
