Update on New Staging

We have a few problems with regard to the staging. Firstly, because Portugal fell outside the safe zone, it would mean that Dave Rands (the guy who has arranged the purchase of the staging) would have 14 days in quarantine on his return from collecting the staging, which he cannot afford to do. So we were looking to have it couriered over on pallets. The next problem came when the company sent an invoice for the staging which included 23% VAT which adds another £600 to the price which was never the deal. So while reporting this to you all, the conversation is still ongoing and I will update you in next month's newsletter.




