#### **The President's Comments**

Once again I have to say what a brilliant show of Members and Guests we had at last month's Meeting. There were over 40. We had a marvelous Raffle and Tea Bar. These took almost £200 in total.

Back to the actual Meeting. This was a slide show by Jim Galbally, and what a great show it was. He well deserved the thanks he got from all the Members present. So can I say to Jim on your behalf "Thank you Jim. Well done".

Last month, when I thanked the people who help the Club by what they do for us and the Club I omitted to mention Micky Pegram and all the ways he serves the Club. So may I say now on your behalf a big "Thank you" to Mick.

It has come to my attention that I inadvertently had a star part in Jim Galbally's slide show, so if I spoilt any part of this show I sincerely apologise. But it is nice to get my picture up in lights. I suppose I am now a star, so if anyone wants an autograph please ask. There will be a small charge towards Club funds. Thank you Ha Ha!!

Once again I would like to thank one and all for a great Meeting. I look forward to the next and seeing you all again.

I believe this to be a Hen Bird Show so sort out one or two and bring them along. No wives. The staging will not support the weight, and we wouldn't know where to stick the Rosette if they happened to win (just joking) – we have smaller Rosettes.

Now the last of my baby Zebras have left the nest box, I hope that is their last nest for this year, but when you breed in a mixed flight you can never tell what will happen.

Today I was looking at all the last Zebra youngsters and I noticed a baby Gouldian about the same age as the last baby Zebras. My thoughts turned to where did this young Gouldian come from? And I had a thought. Did one of my Gouldians lay an egg in the Zebra Finch box and was brought up by the Zebras? This could be the reason why one of the Zebras had blue spots round the gapes as I have not seen this in my other baby Zebras, although I have never taken that much notice. If this is the case will the Zebra parents still carry on feeding said youngster? Once again, the young Zebras are nothing like the parents. One looks like a normal, three look like young Bullfinches, and one looks a creamy pink colour. So the parents must be of mixed colours, not pure bred.

Since writing this part of my article on how my breeding season has gone, I have noticed a few nest boxes with eggs in. One has a full clutch of eggs and a couple of others have a few eggs in each, but, once again, I have a nest of four young Zebras, these again are from a pair of CFW (white) but again they look very dark.

I start to write my piece for the Newsletter the first or second day after the Meeting and carry on till the next Newsletter goes to print, so what I write about my birds is over the month.

As I said earlier I had some eggs in other boxes a week after the Meeting. Two weeks later, one of the nests with eggs had started to hatch. I believe once again they are Zebras. I also saw the other box start to hatch. These are Gouldians. A day or so later I saw a Gouldian Hen with a bad leg. She looked very uncomfortable hobbling around on one leg. I didn't want to chase her around as it may have done more damage to her, but alas, when I checked the box, the babies had gone, so I think she is the Hen to these babies, and another bird had removed the babies. One good thing, the hen is now starting to use her bad leg.

Literallly the day before print I have seen another box of babies hatch. Three babies so far out of six eggs. The young are from a pair of Reds. Again they are dark and light skins. Another thing I have noticed is the parent birds continually revamp the nest around the babies. By the time you get this Newsletter hopefully they will be approximately two weeks old. So again I will be able to see properly the colours.

Well, that's it for now. Barry is back from holiday and wants my scribe for Val to type so he can get printing so that Ken can put the Newsletters in envelopes for posting. As you can see it it's a family job!!

That's it for now folks – till next time.

#### October 2022 Meeting

#### This is the Second Round of the Dagenham CBS Show League 2022

As you know, we changed the format of the show this year to try to give a more balanced outcome.

Members can only enter the maximum of 4 Birds for each show (50p per cage)

The Members will judge the birds again this year. Exhibitors are permitted to judge BUT CANNOT VOTE FOR THEIR OWN BIRDS. This will be checked when the scores are collated.

Each Member/Judge who wants to take part will receive a judging card that they will print their name on at the top and write the cage numbers of the birds they think are best from 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> in each section, British, Mules & Hybrids – Canaries – Foreign

Here are the scores each of those birds will receive  $1^{st} = 10$  points,  $2^{nd} = 8$  points,  $3^{rd} = 6$  points. Any birds that do not receive any votes at all will get 2 points.

After all Members/Judges have finished judging, all of each bird's points will be added together to find their total score to see which bird has won.

#### Prizes for each show

Best Bird in Show – £20.00 + Large Rosette
Best British – Medium Rosette
Best Canary – Medium Rosette
Best Foreign – Medium Rosette

Judging competition winner - £20.00

This will be the Member/Judge who has picked the correct order on their score card the same as the final result. If there is more than one winner the score cards will go into a hat to pick one winner. If there are no correct winners, it will go to a count back, with any score cards that have all the right 3 birds but in the wrong order put into the hat.
