- 5. Exhibitors and Visitors must refrain from Handling the Exhibits or using a Judge Stick.
- 6. In the case of Dispute, Protests must be made in writing to the Society Officials during the course of the show, enclosing a deposit of £15 which will be refunded if the protest is proven to be reasonable.
- 7. The decision of the Dagenham & District CBS Show committee will be final in any protest.
- Cheques and Postal Orders must be made payable to:
 DAGENHAM & DISTRICT CBS ~ and not any Individual of the Society.
- 9. Novice exhibits entered in the wrong classes will be reclassified.
- 10. The Show will be governed by the Dagenham & District CBS Show Rules.


