#### CAGE BIRDS SECTION

The Dagenham and District Cage Bird Society was formed thirty-five years ago. A few people moving from the London Area into Dagenham, and who had been members of societies in their previous districts, decided to form a club in Dagenham. The objects of the club being, the cultivation and keeping of various types of cage bird, including canaries, British, foreign and budgles.

The Club also formed a centre for discussion of topical interests, and has made such progress that it is fair to say it is among the best local Societies in the South Essex Area.

Today, the Society has over a hundred members, and it meets every third Friday of the month at Heath Park Hall. At these meetings there are lectures, combined with slide and film shows, to provide something of interest to every fancier, no matter what species of bird he or she may keep.

Three competing shows, as well as this Town Show, are held every year. Young bird shows in June and July and the Club's Annual in November, when all the Society's trophies are competed for, as per rule book.

As well as competing in their own shows, members of the Club and their exhibits travel many miles throughout the year to compete in other clubs' open shows.

A special feature of the Town Show Cage Bird Marquee is the Children's Pet Class competition, which is open to all visiting children and their pet birds (club members excluded). The competition takes place on the Sunday afternoon, and there is no entry fee. Entry forms for this competition, and any other information for people interested in the "fancy" can be obtained from the Show Secretary's table. Stewards are also on duty throughout the marquee to answer questions and give information.
